New feed-in-tariffs for PV in Greece

Feb. 1st 2012: The Greek Ministry for Environment, Energy and Climate Change announced new feed-in-tariffs for PV. As of February 1st, there is a further 5%-12.5% one-off decrease of tariffs on top of the digression foreseen by the previous legislation. The new tariffs are given below:

Greece installed 426 new MWp of PV in 2011, bringing the cumulative installed capacity to 631 MWp. Greece was in the Top 10 worldwide in 2011 with regard to newly installed PV capacity.
